

## 2017 TOUR OF NOTABLE HOMES

This Grand Queen Anne, circa 1895, with a lovely wrap-around front verandah, is located on one of Westfield's prominent historic avenues. The interior is totally and authentically renovated and boasts sixteen rooms, eight bedrooms, five totally renovated bathrooms and an outstanding 21<sup>st</sup> century kitchen and great room. The décor is tastefully eclectic throughout and the extensive third floor gym is a showplace.



This fabulous new construction, a Mediterranean villa inspired by southern European castles, has an all-stone exterior with four, four-sided gables, and is located in section of town known as Indian Forest because of historical Indian encampments in the area. First floor rooms have mahogany coffered ceilings. The handsome designer flooring woods are six inches wide and pecan stained and the unique kitchen elements are a “must see.”

Plenty of original oversized windows bathe the entire house in light throughout the day in this magnificent Westfield center hall Colonial on a picturesque Highland Avenue lot. Beautifully renovated and tastefully expanded, the residence features many treasured family antiques. The living room has original intricate parquet flooring with a fireplace as the focus. The “farm” kitchen boasts cherry wood countertops with a marble center island. A charming family room displays a spinning wheel and intriguing use of colors.



With a lovely Wychwood address, this home has been professionally re-imagined by the owners and features plenty of unusual touches including family collectables. The children's “art room” is a fabulous advantage adjacent to cozy sitting room with fireplace and professional quality kitchen. The color palette is sophisticated throughout. The functional basement includes a beautiful apartment. Outside, a unique patio with fire pit, BBQ and bar make entertaining here a joy.
